- Grants are from agencies and organizations within various states, federal agencies, and national foundations. The Federal Register is reviewed daily.
- Grants are listed in alphabetical order.
- Eligible entities are identified. Faith-based organizations may be eligible to apply for funding as nonprofits.
- By using “control f” in a Word document or the “Search”  feature in a pdf file, you can search this grant notice using key words such as nonprofit, national, the abbreviation for your state, etc.

- Promote racial, social, economic and environmental justice;
- Have limited financial access or have encountered obstacles in their search for funding, and
- Organizational budget should not exceed \$150,000.
