- Grants are from agencies and organizations within various states, federal agencies, and national foundations. The Federal Register is reviewed daily.
- Grants are listed in alphabetical order.
- Eligible entities are identified. Faith-based organizations may be eligible to apply for funding as nonprofits.
- By using “control f” in a Word document or the “Search”  feature in a pdf file, you can search this grant notice using key words such as nonprofit, national, the abbreviation for your state, etc.

Community Challenge Planning Grants and TIGER II Planning Grants

Availability: Nationally and U.S. territories

Eligible Entities: State and local governments, including U.S. territories, tribal governments, transit agencies, port authorities, metropolitan planning organizations, other political subdivisions of state or local governments, and multi-state or multijurisdictional groupings.

Funder: U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (USHUD) and U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT)

Amount: \$40 million from USHUD and \$45 million for USDOT

(Note: the 20 percent matching requirement does not apply to projects in rural areas.)

Minimum Size Grant: There is no minimum grant size.

Maximum Size Grant: \$3,000,000

Deadline: Pre-applications are due July 26, 2010 at 5:00 p.m. EDT. Applications must be submitted by August 23, 2010 at 5:00 p.m. EDT.

Description: Program goals include: (1) To better align Federal programs to support the building of projects that further the six Livability Principles, and (2) To remove artificial or bureaucratic barriers among Federal programs and create a more coordinated point of contact for State and local government building innovative projects that coordinate housing, economic development, transportation, and environmental policies and goals.
