- Grants are relevant to national welfare reform, workforce development, faith and community-based initiatives, adult education, and more.
- Grants are from agencies and organizations within various states, federal agencies, and national foundations. The Federal Register is reviewed daily.
- Grants are listed in alphabetical order.
- Eligible entities are identified. Faith-based organizations may be eligible to apply for funding as nonprofits.
- By using “control f” in a Word document or the “Search”  feature in a pdf file, you can search this grant notice using key words such as nonprofit, national, the abbreviation for your state, etc.

Patriot Express Loan Initiative

Availability: Nationally

Eligible Entities: Veterans, Service-Disabled Veterans, Active-Duty Service Members eligible for the Military’s Transition Assistance Program, Reservists and National Guard Members, Current Spouses of any of the above. A widowed spouse of a Service Member or Veteran who died during service, or of a service-connected disability.

Funder: U.S. Small Business Administration

Amount: Maximum loan amount is \$500,000.

Description: The Patriot Express loan is offered by the U.S Small Business Administration’s (SBA) network of participating lenders nationwide and features our fastest turnaround time for loan approvals. Loans are available up to \$500,000 and qualify for SBA’s maximum guaranty of up to 85 percent for loans of \$150,000 or less and up to 75 percent for loans over \$150,000 up to \$500,000. For loans above \$350,000, lenders are required to take all available collateral.
